

ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

This Acceptable Use Policy (“AUP”) is made under and subject to the agreement between Worldscape Technology, Inc. (“Worldscape”) and you regarding the Platform Services (as defined in such agreement). This AUP identifies prohibited uses of the Platform Services made available to you. Worldscape may update this AUP upon fifteen (15) days’ notice to you.

Worldscape does not allow the Platform Services to be used for the following:

Illegal, malicious or highly regulated activities. This includes using the Platform Services to:

- Engage in, promote, contribute to, plan, monitor or further illegal or unlawful activity or otherwise violate any applicable law or regulation.
- Automate or substantially automate any decision that adversely impacts an individual’s rights, including employability of individuals.
- Facilitate or encourage any crime, including the exchange of illegal substance or goods or illegal services such as human trafficking or prostitution.
- Exploit, harm or attempt to exploit or harm minors in any way.
- Facilitate weapons, explosives or other dangerous materials.
- Generate or produce information to be used for administration of justice, law enforcement, immigration, asylum or other legal processes.

Deceptive or misleading activities. This includes using the Platform Services to:

- Impersonate a human by presenting results or assessments as human-generated.
- Engage in coordinated inauthentic behavior or disinformation activities.

Abusive or fraudulent activities. This includes using the Platform Services to:

- Attempt to override or circumvent safety filters or intentionally direct the Platform Services to act in a manner that contravenes Worldscape policies (including this AUP).
- Generate or produce verifiably false information or assessments with the purpose of harming others, including for fraudulent activities, scams or malware.
- Compromise security or gain unauthorized access to computer systems or networks, including spoofing and social engineering.
- Violate any individual’s rights, including privacy or publicity rights, as defined in applicable privacy laws and regulations.
- Inappropriately use confidential or personal information.
- Provide content that you do not have the right to submit or that has been previously removed for violating this AUP.
- Interfere with or negatively impact Worldscape or Worldscape service providers’ products or services.
- Utilize analytics or output of the Platform Services to engage in any of the adversarial attacks set forth in the NIST AI 100-2 E2025 publication available at <https://nvlpubs.nist.gov/nistpubs/ai/NIST.AI.100-2e2025.pdf>, including any form of poisoning attack such as model poisoning and data poisoning.

Activities with a high risk of economic harm. This includes using the Platform Services to:

- Engage in multi-level marketing or pyramid schemes.
- Engage in gambling or betting activities.
- Engage in payday lending activities.

Violent, hateful, or threatening activities. This includes using the Platform Services to:

- Further violent extremism.
- Encourage, support or provide instructions on how to commit violent acts against individuals (including self-harm), animals or property.
- Engage in discriminatory or exploitive practices that could cause harm or adverse impact to individuals or communities based on their protected attributes.
- Encourage or support any form of self-harm.
- Shame, disparage, humiliate or harass individuals.

Sexually explicit activities. This includes using the Platform Services to:

- Facilitate the creation of pornographic content or content meant for sexual gratification.
- Encourage or support erotic chats.

EU AI Act. The Platform Services are not designed or intended for use in AI practices classified as “unacceptable risk” under the European Union Artificial Intelligence Act (“**EU AI Act**”), including to create or expand facial recognition databases or to infer emotions in the workplace or educational institutions for non-safety purposes. You are expressly prohibited from using the Platform Services for any purpose that falls within the prohibited AI practices set forth in Article 5 of the EU AI Act. As part of Worldscape’s compliance efforts, you must promptly cooperate with Worldscape’s information requests related to your usage of the Platform Services. Worldscape plans to update this section of the AUP as additional regulations under the EU AI Act come into effect and additional guidelines, codes of practice, harmonised standards and other materials are released.

Child sexual exploitation or abuse activities. Worldscape strictly prohibits and will report to relevant authorities and organizations where appropriate any activity that exploits or harms children, or describes, encourages, supports or promotes any form of child sexual exploitation or abuse in addition to Child Sexual Abuse Material (CSAM).
